

# ALPHABET YOU!

All you need for this activity is a camera!  
You can use your phone or an iPad or tablet.

This creative challenge uses your powers of observation to create a photo code!

## STEP 1

Spell out your name, you can write it down on some paper. Now look at each of the letters that make up your name.

## STEP 2

Now go on a visual hunt, you are trying to find an object that starts with the same letter as each of the letters in your name. You can use your piece of paper to jot down your thoughts. Imagine your name is S-A-R-A-H, you might choose **SOAP- APPLE - ROCK - APPLE - HAIR**

## HINTS + TIPS

Try and make each photograph interesting. Play around with angles and think about your lighting. Make your objects easily recognisable and make sure they are the main feature in your photograph - don't have too many other things in the photo cluttering up your code!

## STEP 3

Photograph each of the objects that start with the same letters as the ones in your name.

## STEP 4

Now review your photographs and choose your best one for each letter. You have made a photo code! Now you can message it to your friends or print the photos out and use them as a signature on a card.

## DO YOU WANT A TOUGHER CHALLENGE?

OK here are some ways to make it a little more tricky!

If you have two of the same letters in your name - like SARAH has two A's - then find a different objects starting with that letter each time. And if you feel very adventurous why not make up a whole alphabet? You'll find Z very tricky!! You can always photograph a drawing of something if you get stuck. You could make a present for a friend by printing out and framing their name in photo code.

Here is my name in photo code. I had fun, it was harder than I thought!
